Improve the internal and external communications of KTCEA	Develop a community engagement and communication plan to improve information sharing with parents, elders, leaders and community partners by spring 2024. Develop an internal communication plan that mitigates communication barriers by spring 2024.

Calls for membership to each School Parent Advisory Circles members takes place annually with SPAC's in place by October of every year Quarterly SPAC meetings are held in each school with training provided to each annually Opportunities provided for youth councils to meet with Chief and Councils. 	Increase the Elder's roles in Education	Opportunities are provided 2 times annually for Elders to attend KTCEA Board meetings. Elders Advisory Committee is regularly involved and provides input, advice and wisdom to shape KTCEA programs An <i>Elder In-Residence</i> program is implemented in every school A meeting with KTC Elders will take place to clarify their role(s) in KTCEA and develop a plan by December 2023.
